The regular meeting of the Gardiner Town Board was held this date at the Gardiner Town Hall at 7 PM. Present were Supervisor Zatz and Councilmen Dukler, Hinson, Reynolds & Wiegand. There were approximately 18± audience members.

SUPERVISOR REPORT

The May Supervisor Report was approved as present on motion of Councilman Wiegand, seconded by Councilman Dukler and carried.

Misc., \$359.70 from Acct No. 00.07.8160.470 CE Landfill Repair to Acct No. 00.07.8160.401 CE Landfill Misc., \$250.35 from Acct No. 00.07.8160.470 CE Landfill Repair to Acct No. 00.07.8160.413 CE Landfill Repair & Maintenance and \$193.65 from Acct No. 00.07.8160.469 CE Surveillance Camera Landfill to Acct No. 00.07.8160.413 CE Landfill Repair & Maintenance. Seconded by Councilman Dukler and carried.

CAMPGROUND OPENING

The Samuel F. Pryor Campground on Route 299 opened officially on June 3 with a ribbon cutting ceremony. Councilman Hinson toured the campground and said that it is a very

appealing layout for a campground. He spoke with the director of Mohonk Preserve Glenn Hoaglund. Mr. Hoaglund has agreed to give the Town a \$2,000 donation to be used for funds to repair the Town Hall. Supervisor Zatz commented that he recently spoke to Mr. Hoaglund and they discussed the possibility of a town wide picnic in late August.

WALLKILL VALLEY RAIL TRAIL

Supervisor Zatz and Councilman Dukler met with the new director of the Wallkill Valley Rail Trail Association to discuss maintenance concerns of the bridge over Forest Glen Road. This weekend the committee will be replacing boards on the deck of the bridge. WVRT Association does constant maintenance along the trail.

LIBRARY – STORYWALK

Supervisor Zatz explained a new and fascinating concept at the Library. Wooden stakes are put up along the Rail Trail with pages from a book attached. The children walk the trail and read the pages of the book as they go along. It has been a big hit.

OPEN SPACE COMMISSION

Councilman Wiegand stated that he has two (2) additional volunteers for the commission. A meeting is scheduled for Wednesday June 17 at 7 PM.

PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR

John Habersberger – commented that the stop sign was down at the Old Ford Road intersection with the Rail Trail.
